2006 Geyserville, \$35

70% zinfandel 18% carignane 10% petite sirah 2% mataro

Ridge has made the Geyserville as a single-site zinfandel in every year since 1966. After fourteen months in barrel, the wine is fully integrated.

Elegant tannins and intense fruit make it enjoyable now; it will be best over the next 8-10 years

2005 Zinfandel Nervo*, \$33

93% zinfandel, 4% petite sirah, 3% carignane

45 barrels produced

This, our tenth vintage from the Nervo Ranch, provided fruit of extraordinary intensity despite a late start to the growing season.

Fortunately, summer weather was unusually warm, ripening the vines by early October. Use of new and one-year-old oak was limited, allowing fruit to dominate. This classic zinfandel will be at its best over the next five to seven years.

2006 Lytton Springs, \$35

80% zinfandel 16% petite sirah 4% carignane After a natural malolactic, twenty of the thirty-four blocks were selected for the 2006.

This classic Lytton Springs was barrel aged for fifteen months.

Approachable now, it has the structure to be cellared and enjoyed over the next ten years.

2002 Syrah*, \$36

76% syrah, 21% grenache, 3% carignane

The dominant fruit is syrah, which also provides structure. Grenache brings an exotic dimension to the fruit, and old-vine carignane adds bright acidity and a touch of elegance. A total of twenty-two months in air dried american oak has brought the tannins and full body into balance, and five years of bottle age will bring further complexity to this fine wine.

2002 Syrah II*, \$36

76% syrah, 22% grenache, 2% viognier

Bright old-vine carignane is replaced here by viognier's spice and floral nuance. After twenty-six months in barrel, this big, complex wine has begun to soften; it will develop further over the next five to seven years.
