From 1972 to 1976, we harvested grapes from the old vines that make up the Valley Vista Vineyard, designating the wine as Lytton Springs. Last year we purchased the vineyard and, in 1990, combined the wines from its hillsides with those from older blocks on the neighboring Norton Ranch, source of our Lytton Springs Zinfandel for the last six years. Together, they gave us intense fruit, balanced tannins, and one of the richest, most complex zinfandels of recent memory. Lovely now, it will develop further over the next five or six years.
