Late-spring rains in 1991 provided much-needed ground water, while a warm Indian summer ensured full ripeness. Intense petite sirah from the Railroad Block and ripe carignan from the 19th-century Triangle and Whitten Blocks shine against the rich background of old-vine zinfandel. Elegant, accessible and well-structured, this wine, like its predecessors, will age beautifully. PD (1/93)
