The 1992 is our twenty-seventh vintage from this great vineyard, whose climate and gravelly soils together contribute a definition and elegance not often associated with zinfandel. The old carignan and petite sirah are fermented with floating cap and extensive pump-overs, the zinfandel with submerged cap--for long, gentle extraction. While characteristic of the year, the wine clearly equals the 1990 and 1991. It has the structure to develop over ten or more years; the appealing fruit will be most intense in the wine's youth.
