97 Lytton Springs Vineyard, bottled Feb 99 Anticipating El Niño by a year, the winter of 1996/1997 brought serious flooding throughout California—but with a difference: almost no rain fell after February. The mild, stormfree spring allowed the earliest and largest set in our twenty-six-year history with this vineyard. To ensure intensity and full ripeness, we dropped a third of the crop on the young vines, and ten percent on the oldstill achieving record yields. Taking advantage of unusually rapid color and tannin extraction, we let the skins float during fermentation, rather than keeping them submerged. Delicious now, the 1997 is ripe and rustic—classic, "old-style" Lytton Springs. Its lush fruit will be most appealing over the next five years. PD (1/99)
