As with our single-vineyard wines, the grapes are harvested by hand, fermented on native yeasts and aged in small cooperage. Cool summer weather delayed ripening; we began harvesting in mid-September, finishing in late October. We chose the most accessible lots from eight ranches for the 2011. This elegant wine has generous fruit, and will be most enjoyable over the next four to five years. JO (12/12)
