


- Elegant fresh citrus entry, ginger root limestone earth, lemon zest finish. — Eric Baugher, Winemaker at Monte Bello, February 2016








- Good availability.
- Ridge first made merlot in 1974 from the Point, the highest, most exposed block on the Monte Bello vineyard at an elevation of 2600'.

- The 1967 vintage was our first wine from the Dusi Ranch.
- The vineyard was planted to zinfandel in 1922 which is unusual because Prohibition had started two years earlier.
