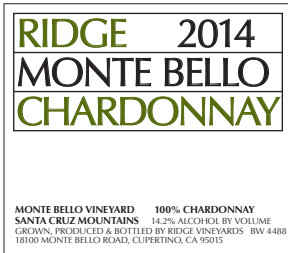


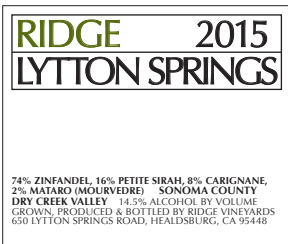

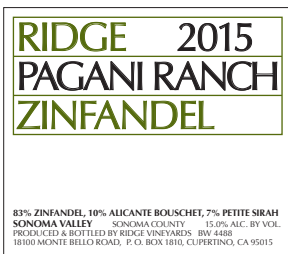
Very limited availability.

*From 1962 to 1984, four to eight barrels of chardonnay were produced each year under the Monte Bello designation. By 1985, younger, replanted vines had begun to supplant the older vines, and we changed the designation to Santa Cruz Mountains (now Estate). As the young vines matured; we were able to select, in most years, several exceptional parcels for a Monte Bello Chardonnay.*



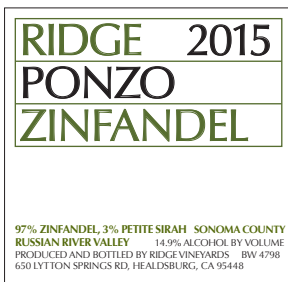

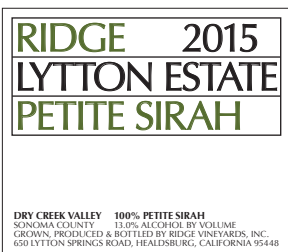
