74% ZINFANDEL 16% PETITE SIRAH 8% CARIGNANE 2% MATARO (MOURVEDRE)

Winemaker's Notes: Rain during the first week of April, though welcome, disrupted flowering reducing yields. The fruit ripened quickly in the warm summer weather. Harvest began August 17, the earliest ever. We managed extraction of color and tannin by limiting pump-overs to once daily. After malolactic, we chose twenty-four of the thirtythree separate fermentations for their concentrated fruit and elegant structure. This excellent vintage is appealing now and will improve over the next ten years. JO (11/16)

RIDGE 2015 PAGANI RANCH ZINFANDEL

83% ZINFANDEL 10% ALICANTE BOUSCHET 7% PETITE SIRAH

Winemaker's Notes: A cool start to the growing season delayed flowering until after the spring storms, giving us a full crop. A warm summer ripened the grapes for a late September harvest. During fermentation rich tannins and color were extracted. After sixteen months in barrel, this sensuous wine shows great appeal. It will be most enjoyable over the next ten to twelve years. EB (2/17)



Winemaker's Notes: Favorable spring weather helped set a full crop at the Ponzo vineyard. The temperate climate of the Russian River Valley typically delays harvest into October, but by early September the grapes were fully ripe. After a natural yeast fermentation, we chose the Old Vines block for its structure and the Front and Back blocks for their intense fruit and aromatics. This sumptuous zinfandel will be best over the next six years. JO (8/16)

Winemaker's Notes: Gary Blasi has been farming this three-acre vineyard for over forty years. Located in the Chalk Hill AVA, these gnarly, head-trained vines are over 100 years old. Our first vintage of Blasi Zinfandel offers plentiful fruit, a full, soft texture and balanced acidity. Enjoyable on release, it will continue developing for another five years. JO (8/16)
