Abundant rains ended the five year drought. A cold spring slowed vine growth, but a warm summer brought harvest back to a normal schedule. Eight days of fermentation, on average, produced an elegant tannin structure. American oak, used in aging, complements the beautiful fruit of this excellent vintage.
