- Opaque purple-ruby color. Ripe blackberry fruit, barrel spice, anise, violets, and crushed limestone. Opulent mountain fruit entry, firm acid, and finegrain, age-worthy tannins. Powerful complexity and tremendous length to the finish. EB (1/18)

#### RIDGE 2017 LYTTON SPRINGS

- Good Availability
- In 1972, Ridge made its first Lytton Springs from vines planted on the eastern half of the vineyard at the turn of the century.
- Nose of plum, blackberry and licorice. Plentiful raspberry fruit on entry with notes of pepper sage, well coated tannins and long layered finish. JO (7/19)

- RIDGE 2017 PAGANI RANCH ZINFANDEL
- Good Availability
- Since 1991, Ridge has made zinfandel from the Pagani vineyard on the western side of Sonoma Valley. The majority of the vineyard was planted ninety to one hundred twenty years ago.
- Focused jammy blueberry fruit and pepper on the nose. On the palate, fresh cherry, mineral, firm acidity, balanced structure and long lingering finish. JO (7/19)

- Limited Availability
- The old vines contribute depth and richness; the young vines add elegant, layered fruit. Enjoyable upon release, this sumptuous zinfandel will develop over the next five years.
- Nose of raspberry, guava and floral notes. Bright cherry fruit on the palate with refreshing acidity, elegant tannins and finishes with an accent of pepper. JO (7/19)

94% PETITE SIRAH, 6% ZINFANDEL DRY CREEK VALLEY SONOMA COUNTY 13.8% ALCOHOL BY VOLUME GROWN, PRODUCED & BOTTLED BY RIDGE VINEYARDS, INC. 650 LYTTON SPRINGS ROAD, HEALDSBURG, CALIFORNIA 95448

- Limited Availability
- We made our first wine from the property in 1972. In 2002, we began bottling portions of the petite sirah as a separate wine for a limited release, up until then it had always been included in the Lytton Springs Zinfandel.
- Deep dark purplish-black color, peppery, floral aromas. Full bodied with rich layered plum and fig fruit on the palate. Well coated tannins and a long minerally finish. JO (7/19)

## RIDGE 2018 GRENACHE BLANC

75% GRENACHE BLANC, 15% PICPOUL, 10% ROUSSANNE ADELAIDA VINEYARD PASO ROBLES 14.0% ALC BY VOL PRODUCED & BOTTLED BY RIDGE VINEYARDS 18100 MONTE BELLO ROAD, CUPERTINO, CALIFORNIA 95014

- Very Limited Availability
- The Adelaida District is well-suited to growing superb white Rhône varietals. Located in the hills west of Paso Robles, thirteen miles from the Pacific Ocean, its limestone subsoils produce wines with excellent mineral character.
- Pale gold color. Aromas of citrus and green plum, white flowers, complex minerals, and exotic oak spices. Lemon, pear, and tart pineapple fruits on entry, refreshing acidity, and a medium body; Long, citrus zest aftertaste. EB (6/19)
