
## **TERMINOLOGY**



**BASAL LOBE:** Somewhat rounded section of the blade located on the side of the leaf, in its lower quadrant.

**LATERAL LOBE:** Somewhat rounded section of the blade located on the side of the leaf, in its upper quadrant.

**APICAL LOBE:** Somewhat rounded section of the blade comprising the apex of the leaf.

**PETIOLE:** The stem that attaches the leaf blade of the shoot.

**PETIOLAR SINUS:** Indentation of the leaf's main part, where it attaches to the petiole.

**BASAL SINUS:** Indentation of the leaf's main part, separating the upper lateral lobe from the lower lateral lobe.

**LATERAL SINUS:** Indentation of the leaf's main part, separating the terminal lobe from the upper lateral lobe.

**LEAF MARGIN:** Edge of leaf, or the "teeth".
