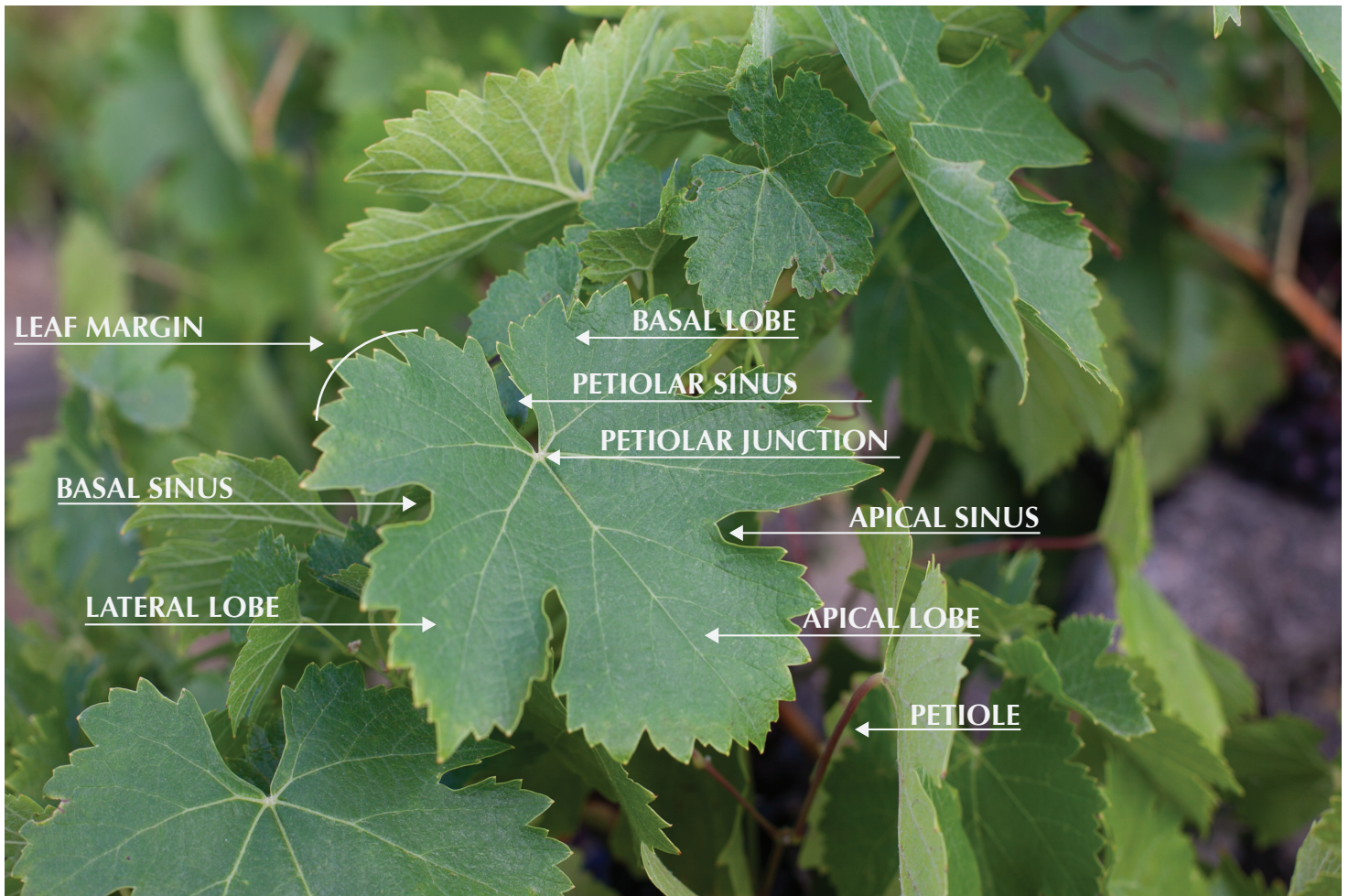


TERMINOLOGY



BASAL LOBE: Somewhat rounded section of the blade located on the side of the leaf, in its lower quadrant.

LATERAL LOBE: Somewhat rounded section of the blade located on the side of the leaf, in its upper quadrant.

APICAL LOBE: Somewhat rounded section of the blade comprising the apex of the leaf.

PETIOLE: The stem that attaches the leaf blade to the shoot.

PETIOLAR SINUS: Indentation of the leaf's main part, where it attaches to the petiole.

BASAL SINUS: Indentation of the leaf's main part, separating the upper lateral lobe from the lower lateral lobe.

LATERAL SINUS: Indentation of the leaf's main part, separating the terminal lobe from the upper lateral lobe.

LEAF MARGIN: Edge of leaf, or the "teeth".
