Winemaker's Notes: After several early harvests, 2018 began on September 4, a more typical start date for Sonoma County. Natural yeast fermentations were slow but steady. Color and tannin were plentiful after just three days of maceration. To manage tannin extraction, we limited pumpovers to once a day for all petite sirah and many zinfandel lots. Winemaker's Notes: Due to the cool microclimate at Pagani Ranch, it is usually the last zinfandel vineyard we pick. To encourage ripening, we pulled leaves and dropped all of the largest clusters. We harvested the young vine zinfandel on October 10 and finished two days later with the alicante. Bright acidity and layered fruit typify this sensuous wine. It will gain complexity over the next seven to eight years. JO (2/20)

Winemaker's Notes: 2018 provided ideal growing conditions at the Ponzo vineyard. Cooler conditions typical of the Russian River Valley appellation tempered July heat spikes. A smaller crop in the Old Vine block concentrated flavor and structure. Firm acidity from the younger vines in the Back block focuses fruit and softens the mouthfeel. This elegant, approachable zinfandel will be enjoyable over the next five to six years. JO (10/19)

Winemaker's Notes: This is our second release from this three-acre benchland vineyard in Dry Creek. As with most Sonoma zinfandel, in 2018 the vines set a full but balanced crop. Warm summer weather subsided in the last half of August. The cooling trend extended the ripening period, allowing flavors to fully develop. Ten months aging in american oak brings spice to the plentiful fruit. Enjoyable now, this classic Dry Creek zinfandel will evolve over the next six years. JO (6/19)
