- Opaque-saturated ruby in color. Aromas of cassis, fennel, cola, clove-nutmeg spice, toasted oak, wet crushed stone, black tea, and sweet dry chaparral. Palate of ripe cassis, blackberry, and mountain bramble. Lively acid and polished velvety tannins with a smooth full body and long finish showing limestone mineral and forest floor. EB (4/20)


- Good Availability
- In 1972, Ridge made its first Lytton Springs from vines planted on the eastern half of the vineyard at the turn of the century.
- Appealing nose of pepper, and raspberry. Layered plum, blackberry and cocoa on the palate with chalky tannins and a lingering finish. JO (1/21)

- Good Availability
- Since 1991, Ridge has made zinfandel from the Pagani vineyard on the western side of Sonoma Valley. The majority of the vineyard was planted ninety to one hundred twenty years ago.
- Rich plum and blueberry on the nose with floral notes. Medium to full-bodied on the palate with ample blackberry, currant, and dark chocolate. Balanced structure with supple texture and a long, layered finish. MB (7/21)





- Very Limited Availability
- The Adelaida District is well-suited to growing superb white Rhône varietals. Located in the hills west of Paso Robles, thirteen miles from the Pacific Ocean, its limestone subsoils produce wines with excellent mineral character.
- Pale-gold color. Aromas of green apple, lime, and a hint of cut green grass. Tart citrus fruit and firm acid on entry. Crushed rock mineral and a rich, clean aftertaste. SI (7/21)
