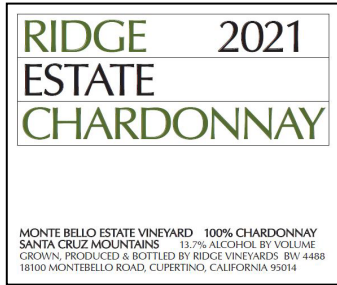

2021 Estate Chardonnay (Santa Cruz Mountains)

Source: Rainfall was scarce through the winter months with less than 15 inches of rain. Spring and summer temperatures allowed for slow and even ripening. Harvest began in late August; we picked steadily over the next three weeks. Whole cluster pressed, barrel fermented and sur lees aged for nine months, this complex, elegant chardonnay will be enjoyable over the next six years. TG (11/22)

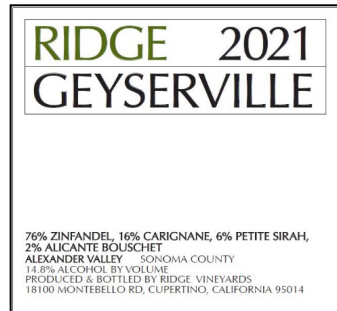

2020 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon (Santa Cruz Mountains)

Source: Late spring rains disrupted fruit set in the merlot and yields were likewise down in petit verdot. With less of these two varieties to work with, cabernet sauvignon makes up a larger proportion of this year's wine. All the grapes were destemmed but left as whole berries for slower, gentler extraction during fermentation. After nineteen months of barrel aging, tannins are well integrated. This exemplary mountain grown cabernet will develop more fully over the next fifteen years. JO (6/22)

2021 Geyserville (Alexander Valley)

Source: First produced in 1966, we have made this zinfandel every year for fifty-six years. Consistency of quality and vineyard character are its hallmarks. A dry winter with a moderate spring and summer ripened the grapes evenly. Showing plentiful fruit, elegant tannins and bright acidity, this fine wine will develop fully over the next fourteen years. 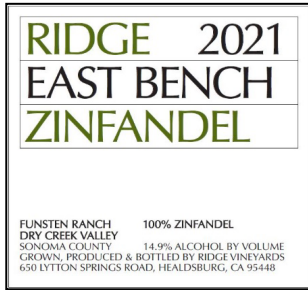

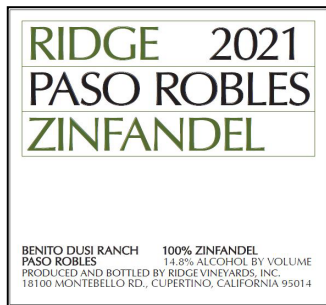

2021 East Bench Zinfandel (Dry Creek Valley)

Source: This vineyard sits atop a high bench overlooking Dry Creek Valley. It is one of our only vineyards planted solely to zinfandel. This year the vines again set a small crop and ripened quickly. All eight parcels were harvested the first week of September. Seven were selected for their exuberant fruit. This excellent wine will be at its best over the next ten years. SR (10/22)

2021 Paso Robles Zinfandel (Paso Robles)

Source: During a very dry winter the vines were given two long, deep irrigations that provided the water needed to set a good crop. Despite a July heat spike, harvest unfolded in ideal conditions. The wine shows the exotic spice typical of the vineyard and the freshness of firm acidity. Fifteen months in oak has brought these elements into balance. Enjoyable on release, it will develop further over the next eight years. TG (10/22)
