





- Very Limited Availability
- Mild temperatures in March prompted an early bloom that coincided with the spring rains. This resulted in a smaller crop that, accompanied by more summer fog than usual, allowed for slow, steady ripening into September.
- Opaque ruby color–Ripe cassis, plum, and red currant fruit, toasty oak barrel spice, vanilla, fennel, juniper berry, bay laurel, well-integrated velvety tannins, full mid-palate, firm acid, long, sumptious finish. IO (3/21)


- Good Availability
- In 1972, Ridge made its first Lytton Springs from vines planted on the eastern half of the vineyard at the turn of the century.
- Nose of red and black raspberry, white pepper, fennel, sage, dark chocolate and sarsaparilla. Full bodied with notes of blackberry and ripe plum; juicy acidity, excellent mid-palate weight and a lengthy finish. SR (11/22)



Good Availability

- Since 1991, Ridge has made zinfandel from the Pagani vineyard on the western side of Sonoma Valley. The majority of the vineyard was planted ninety to one hundred twenty years ago.
- Nose of jammy blueberry, red cherry and pepper. Lively acidity and structure give this wine a full mouthfeel with notes of raspberry, mineral and dark chocolate with a lingering finish. SR (11/22)



- Very Limited Availability
- The oldest petite sirah vines on our Lytton Estate were planted in 1901 and the youngest in 2008. We made our first wine from the property in 1972. In 2002, we began bottling portions of the petite sirah as a separate wine for a limited release.
- Midnight purple in color with medium-full to full body. Rich black currant and plum on the nose. Complex and well-structured, with supple tannin, juicy bramble fruit, and notes of cardamom spice and smoked meat. MB (6/23)
- Limited Availability
- Fourteen miles inland, this unique growing area creates conditions well suited to grenache blanc. The grapes were whole cluster pressed, fermented dry, and aged on the lees for six months.
- Attractive, golden color. Aromas of white flowers, peach, ripe melon, pineapple, key lime and wet stone. A bright and clean entry with Medium body. Complex mouthfeel with minerality and fresh natural acidity lead to a mouthwatering finish. TG (3/23)

- Good Availability
- Since its inception Ridge has focused on single vineyard wines. Three Valleys is our winemakers wine, made by carefully combining parcels from a number of different vineyards.
- Nose of toasty oak, strawberry jam, mixed berry pie, black tea and baking spice. Layered black and blue fruit on the palate with milk chocolate, cherry, garrigue and textured tannins on the finish. SR (1/23)
