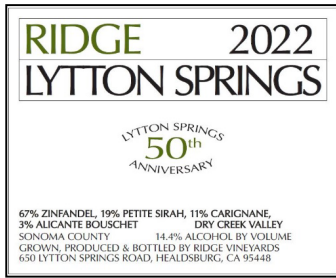


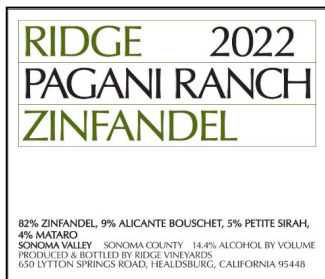

2022 Lytton Springs (Dry Creek Valley)

Source: An early spring and mild weather contributed to a uniform but moderate set. A May frost reduced yields in some blocks, but as each parcel is on its own timing for bud break, most of the vineyard was spared. The rich fruit, refreshing acidity and firm tannin of this complex wine showcase the balance and quality typical of an exceptional vineyard. Approachable even as a young wine, this classic zinfandel will continue to evolve over the next ten to fifteen years. SR (11/23)

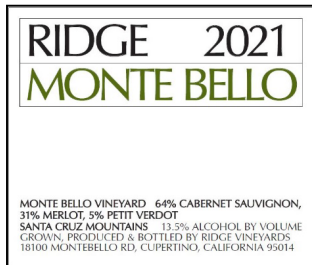

2022 Pagani Ranch Zinfandel (Sonoma Valley)

Source: Early flowering and mild summer weather provide excellent growing conditions. This vineyard in the cool Sonoma Valley is always the last zinfandel picked, but this year it ripened early. It came in over five days in mid-September. Selected blocks of old vines planted between 1896 and 1922 give depth of flavor and texture. The younger vines add intense fruit and racy acidity. This fine wine will be most enjoyable over the next ten years. SR (11/23)

2021 Monte Bello (Santa Cruz Mountains)

Source: Warm weather in August, especially at the higher elevations, expedited ripeness. For the first time, we harvested from the top vineyard at Perrone to the bottom at Klein. The drought reduced yields by more than a third resulting in small berries with exceptional tannin and color concentration. This year instead of all parcels finishing malolactic in barrel as in the past, sixty percent finished in tank. This classic Monte Bello will develop over the next twenty to twenty-five years. 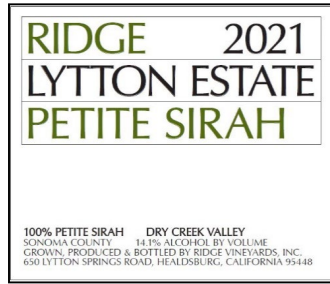

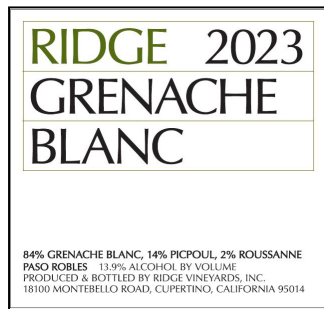

2021 Lytton Estate Petite Sirah (Dry Creek Valley)

Source: A dry winter brought only 13" of rain. All eight petite sirah parcels were harvested between September first and September twenty-fourth and fermented separately. Of those, seven were chosen for their depth of color and rich texture. To manage tannin extraction, pump overs were limited to once daily. Built to last, this lovely, powerful wine will age twelve to fifteen years. SR (3/23)

2023 Grenache Blanc (Paso Robles)

Source: Limestone soils and proximity to the Pacific provide ideal growing conditions for grenache blanc to thrive. The grapes were pressed as whole clusters, fermented, and then aged on the lees for six months. The wine has great concentration, bright acidity, and appealing minerality. This delightful wine is enjoyable now or can be aged for four to five years. TG (2/24)
