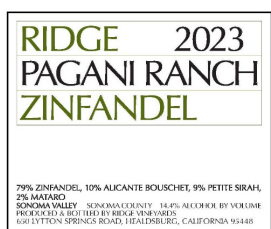

2023 Lytton Springs (Dry Creek Valley)

Source: A cold, rainy winter and a cool summer pushed the growing season back, slowing ripening. Harvest began on September 23 and finished on October 24. The twenty-eight parcels that produced the most typical Lytton Springs were combined and racked to barrel. Fine tannins, moderate ripeness and focused fruit are hallmarks of the vintage. This elegant wine is enjoyable now, and has the structure to evolve over the next ten years. SR (12/24)

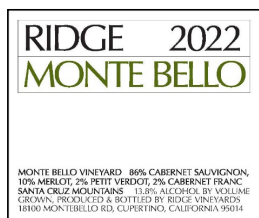

2023 Pagani Ranch Zinfandel (Sonoma Valley)

Source: A late winter and cool spring set back the growing season, pushing bloom into June. The nineteenth-century zinfandel vines ripened by early October; the younger vines ten days later. The tannic petite sirah, red-fleshed alicante and savory mataro add an intriguing hint of rusticity. This elegant Pagani exemplifies the complexity that can be drawn from an old field blend. This complex wine will age beautifully over the next seven to eight years. SR (1/25)

2022 Monte Bello (Santa Cruz Mountains)

Source: A third year of drought accompanied by a heat wave during ripening, reduced yields. To manage tannins, all grapes were fermented as whole berries, pressed once dry, and transferred to American oak for natural malolactic. Eighteen of thirty-one lots were selected by blind tasting and, after assemblage, spent an additional twenty months in barrel. This classic Monte Bello will evolve over the next twenty to twenty-five years. JO (10/24)

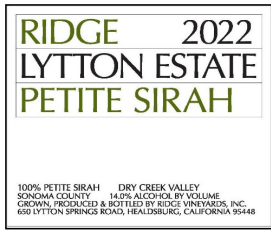

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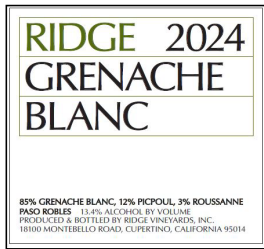

2022 Lytton Estate Petite Sirah (Dry Creek Valley)

Source: Mild summer weather evenly ripened the petite sirah at Lytton West. By September seventh, the hillside blocks of dark, tightly packed clusters had accumulated enough sugar to begin picking. Five days later, the parcels at the lowest elevation were ready as well. Five of the blocks were chosen for their deep color, rich texture and complexity. This exemplary wine will continue to develop over the next ten years. SR (3/24)

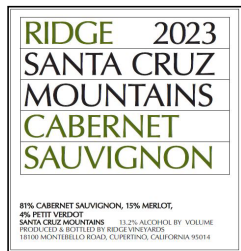

2024 Grenache Blanc (Paso Robles)

Source: In 2018, we first produced a small amount of Grenache Blanc from the Adelaida vineyard. Impressed with the balance of minerality, firm acidity and subtle stone fruit, we now source grenache blanc, picpoul, and roussanne from three vineyards on the west side of Paso Robles. After whole cluster pressing, this wine was aged for eight months in five year old barrels and bottled early to preserve freshness. Delicious now, it will develop fully over five years. JO (4/25)

2023 Santa Cruz Mountains Cabernet Sauvignon (Santa Cruz Mountains)

Source: From 1978 to 2007 Ridge produced a cabernet-based Santa Cruz Mountains bottling. In 2008 the name changed to Estate Cabernet to highlight the fact that all the grapes for that wine are grown by Ridge and come from the Monte Bello vineyard. In 2023 we purchased grapes from several high quality growers in the Santa Cruz Mountains. We decided to revive this label to indicate that the grapes for this wine, rather than being farmed by Ridge, come from outside growers. JO (4/25)
