• Extemely Limited Availability



10% MERLOT, 2% PETIT VERDOT, 2% CABERNET FRANC SANTA CRUZ MOUNTAINS 13.8% ALCOHOL BY VOLUME GROWN, PRODUCED & BOTTLED BY RIDGE VINEYARDS 18100 MONTEBELLO RD, CUPERTINO, CALIFORNIA 95014



76% ZINFANDEL, 14% PETITE SIRAH, 7% CARIGNANE, 2% ALICANTE BOUSCHET, 1% MATARO DRY CREEK VALLEY SONOMA COUNTY 14.4% ALCOHOL BY VOLUME GROWN, PRODUCED & BOTTLED BY RIDGE VINEYARDS 650 LYTTON SPRINGS ROAD, HEALDSBURG, CA 95448

- A third year of drought accompanied by a heat wave during ripening, reduced yields. To manage tannins, all grapes were fermented as whole berries, pressed once dry, and transferred to American oak for natural malolactic. Eighteen of thirty-one lots were selected by blind tasting and, after assemblage, spent an additional twenty months in barrel.
- Saturated ruby color. Intense aromas of blackberry, black currant, fennel, dry chaparral, tobacco leaf, crushed stone, and toasted oak. On the palate, rich mountain bramble and cassis, polished tannins, and full bodied. Natural firm acidity leads to a long finish showing limestone minerality. JO (11/24)
- Good Availability
- In 1972, Ridge made its first Lytton Springs from vines planted on the eastern half of the vineyard at the turn of the century. The vineyard is planted to zinfandel and its principal complementary varietals.
- Nose of raspberry, pepper, licorice and a hint of vanilla. Black cherry and plum on the palate with supple tannins, minerality and present acidity. Long, layered finish with notes of garrigue and black tea. SR (7/25)





- Good Availability
- Since 1991, Ridge has made zinfandel from the Pagani vineyard on the western side of Sonoma Valley. The majority of the vineyard was planted ninety to one hundred twenty years ago.
- Enticing nose of strawberry, guava, fennel and orange zest. Flavors of briary blackberry, vanilla, toasty oak. Bright acidity with well-coated tannins and a long finish. SR (6/25)

- The oldest petite sirah vines on our Lytton Estate were planted in 1901 and the youngest in 2008. We made our first wine from the property in 1972. In 2002, we began bottling portions of the petite sirah as a separate wine for a limited
- Dark opaque black color, briary blackberry fruit nose with a hint of pepper, full bodied, well coated tannins on the palate, vanilla mint and floral notes with a long finish. JO (1/25)

- In 2023 we purchased grapes from several high quality growers in the Santa Cruz Mountains. We decided to revive the Santa Cruz Mountains label to indicate that the grapes for this wine, rather than being farmed by Ridge, come from outside growers.
- Aromas of black olive, tobacco leaf, and cocoa. On the • palate, well-coated tannins, blackberry fruit, and balanced acidity, with notes of licorice and cedar in the long, lingering finish. JO(6/25)

- Good Availability
- After whole cluster pressing, the wine was aged for eight months in five year old barrels and bottled early to preserve freshness. Delicious now, it will develop fully over five years.
- Honeysuckle and citrus blossom on the nose. Subtle pear and apricot fruit on the palate with mineral notes and bright refreshing acidity on the finish. JO(6/25)
